CAAM's Young Docent Program begins, June 20, 2011 with an intensive, two-week summer training in which students gain specialized knowledge of museum exhibitions and programs.

To apply, send to us by May 20, 2011 the following:

1. a typed personal statement about yourself and why you would like to be a Young Docent
2. A letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or school principal
3. A completed application

Gallery Services: July 5 th through August 19 th
Certificate Ceremony: August 19 th

To be eligible for the Young Docents Summer Program candidate must be available for training and work in gallery services through August 19th

Once candidates are selected, they must obtain the following mandatory items:

1. T.B. Skin test
2. Fingerprinting (State of California)
3. A work permit
